

This fiscal year, IdahoRID provided 6 workshops and 5 mini workshops.

Mini workshops averaged over 50 registrants with 15 different states represented.

Most popular mini workshop was Orlando Obeso's, "Let Me TRI and Explain ASL/English/Spanish" with 85 registrants.

An MOU between the Council for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing (CDHH) and IdahoRID pays for the Mini Workshops and allows us to provide them free to membership.


